Given below are some well accepted colors and patterns










#### It may be wise to avoid ties with images and designer logos






#### To wear a suit will be more preferable

# **Dressing Code - Female**

Avoid sleeveless and tightfitting clothes

You may wear a Long tunic near of knee or under knee with a pair of formal trousers.

#### SHOES/SANDALS

Shoes with 1 ½ - inch heels are standard. You may wear

a pair with smaller heels or a flat pair. Stick with

a black/brown pair preferable.

Be sure your shoes are polished

Do not wear colorful sandals

## **ACCESSORIES**

Earrings
Wear stubs or small rings
